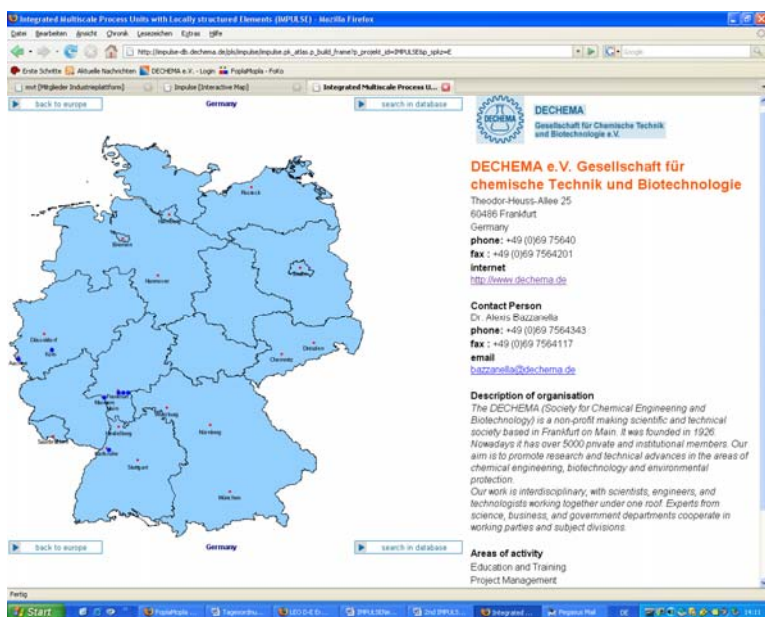


The Interactive Map, a new addition to the IMPULSE website
